## 2022 Defining the Future Grant Recipients Announced

The AAPP Foundation was encouraged by the submissions from students, residents, and fellows who are working to improve the lives of people living with mental disorders and their caregivers. A requirement of the <u>Defining the Future grant program</u> is that the research project must mirror the <u>mission and vision</u> of the AAPP Foundation. After a thorough evaluation process, the grant selection team chose four projects to receive grant funding. The award recipients are as follows (in alphabetical order):

- Matthew Nuebel, PharmD, PGY1 Resident, Providence St. Patrick Hospital: "Major Adverse Events and Drug Discontinuation of Clozapine Based on Accordance to an International Titration Guideline"
- Lusi Zhang, PharmD, MHI, PhD Student, University of Minnesota College of Pharmacy, Department of Experimental and Clinical Pharmacology (ECP): "Real-World Utilization and Impact of Psychiatric Pharmacogenomic Testing in a Large Health System"
